




Her's was a devout and prayerful family.

Love for prayer and for the poor was instilled in all the five children right from their childhood.



Sophie took the name Sister Veronica of the Passion.




A Congregation is born: Saint Joseph's Carmel Bayonne, France, July 16 1868

Seeing the need to begin a Carmel for the missions Mother Veronica sent three of her sisters namely Sisters Elias, Marie DesAnges, Mary of St. Joseph to India.
