Carmel Convent School, New Delhi virtually organized **EUNOIA 2021- The English Week from 23rd to 27th August 2021**. Various intra-class events were held on each day to celebrate the language.

The week long events commenced with **Pen It Down And Act It Out**, a story writing and acting competition where teams of four from **class 6** scripted and enacted a story. This competition gave the students a platform to engage in creative writing.

On 24th August 2021, students of **class 7** participated in **The Poem Fleet**, a poetry competition which required the participants to choose “Romantic Poets” from W Wordsworth, P B Shelley, Lord Byron, John Keats, S T Coleridge and recite their poem with utmost depth and appropriate articulation. Poetry competition not only allowed the students to showcase their love for literature but also to engage in the beauty of nature with the romantic poets.

Drama is a strong medium of communication. In order to develop dramatic skills and acting ability among students, **Steal The Spotlight**, a Dramatic Monologue competition was organized for the students of **class 8** on 25th August 2021. The event encountered a huge response from the students. Students were seen enacting dramatic monologues from the literary craftsman William Shakespeare’s plays “The Tempest” and “Othello”.

Owing to the pandemic, students were asked not to rent the costumes rather creatively use the clothes available at home to portray the characters. It was a pleasure to watch the students showcase the characters in their creatively designed Elizabethan costumes.

War of Words, a debate competition was held on 26th August 2021 on the topic **“Art must be integrated with the teaching and learning process of all subjects”** for the students of **class 9**. There was a constant flow of knowledge and exchange of diverse viewpoints which led to live intellectual interjections. E-Certificates were awarded to the best speaker For & Against the motion and Best interjector.

Students of **class 11** participated in the **Book Discussion** held on 27th August 2021. The book selected for discussion this year was ***Tuesdays With Morrie***. The participants were to read and write a 700-750 word academic paper critically analyzing its themes and characters. E-certificates were awarded to the three best submissions.

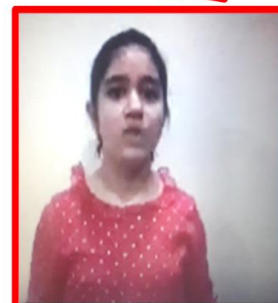
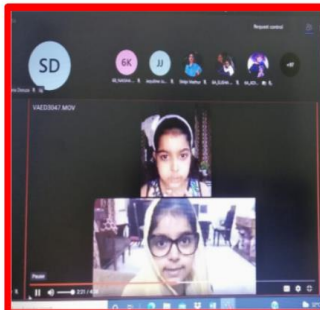
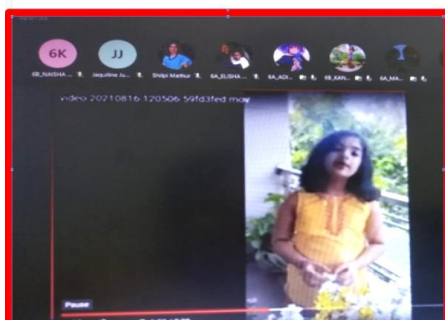
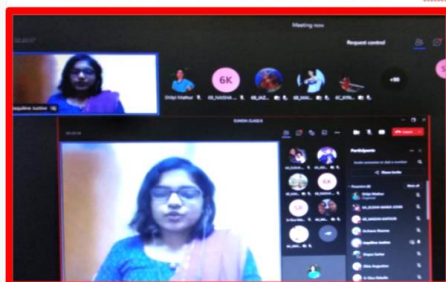
