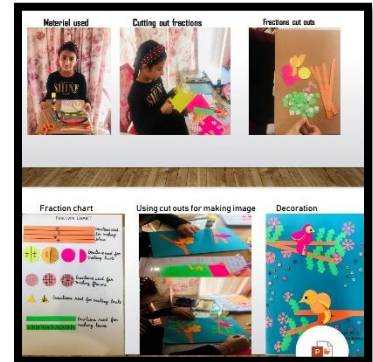


"FUN with FRACTIONS"

Competitive spirit is important for character building amongst young children. It not only prepares them for the future but also helps develop qualities like resilience and tenacity.

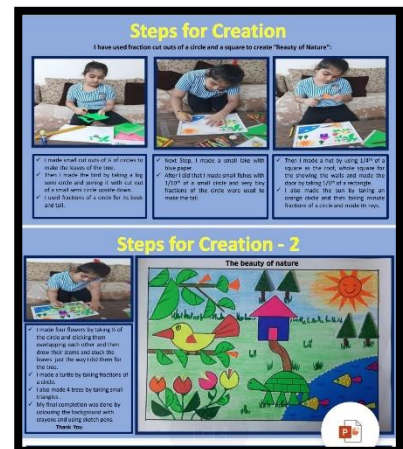


Therefore, to combine fun and education, a competition namely 'Fun with Fractions' was

Steps


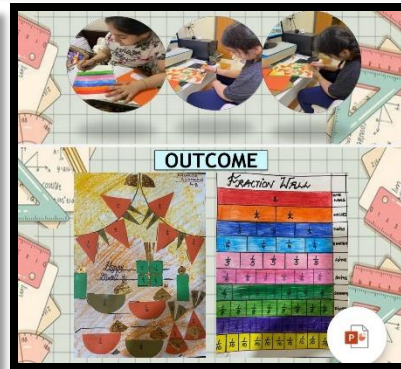
Hands: Cut a square. Square is folded two times to get the fraction of $1/4$

Face: Cut a rectangle and fold it once to get fraction of $1/2$.

Stomach: A semicircle (fraction of $1/2$ of circle) is folded two times making it into semicircle finally to get the fraction of $1/8$. Now take a rectangle strip and fold the rectangle 4 times to get fraction of $1/16$.



Feet: A small circle is folded and cut into two parts to form two semicircles (fraction of $1/2$). The semicircles are folded further to final get a fraction of $1/4$
