IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- ▶ The text book should be read minutely and thoroughly as CBSE focuses on close reading of the subject content.
- ▶ 75 % attendance is compulsory in class XI.
- ▶ Please ensure that your ward studies regularly at home.
- ▶ Newspaper reading is compulsory.
- ▶ Assignments and projects should be submitted on time.



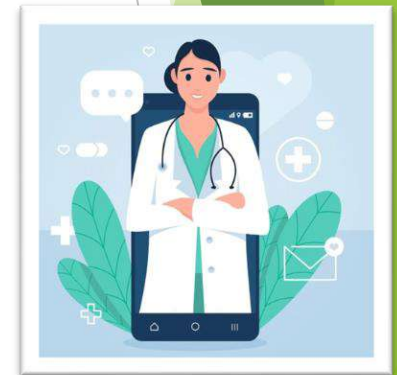
IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- ▶ Parents of Science students should gauge the academic abilities of their wards before enrolling them in professional coaching classes for Engineering / Medicine.
- ▶ Students are unable to take the additional burden and as a result have failed the year.
- ▶ In order to be declared pass, a student must secure 33% marks in each of the subjects. Each student must secure 33% marks **separately in theory and practical Exams.**

Instructions

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- ▶ In case a child is absent due to ill health during examination, the parents should give a written application to the Principal citing the reason for the absence .
- ▶ This must be followed by a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner within 3 days.
- ▶ Science students are cautioned against missing any Lab periods as reconducting experiments at a later date becomes both difficult and unfeasible.





IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- ▶ Inform the class teacher and office immediately in case of a change in your address and telephone numbers.
- ▶ No student is allowed to carry a cell phone to school. If found, the cell phone will be confiscated.
- ▶ In case of an emergency, parent should send an application addressed to the Principal citing the reasons for carrying the mobile. Students should deposit phones in the Principal's office which will be returned after school hours.



IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- ▶ Parents must ensure wards attend school in proper uniform.
- ▶ We discourage students from possessing, carrying or wearing expensive items to school.
- ▶ Nail polish, colouring of hair, highlighting hair will be taken as violation of school rules.
- ▶ Students are not allowed to celebrate their birthdays in school.
- ▶ Parents kindly monitor your ward and ration their time spent on the net.
- ▶ Kindly note school timings are from 7.15 a.m. to 1.35 p.m. Students travelling by private transport are requested to ensure that they reach school in due time.

- ▶ Attending **PTM** and meeting teachers is mandatory for parents. We have three PTMs during the academic year, i.e. in July, October and March.

- ▶ Appointment has to be taken for any such purpose.

Promotion Rules followed in Class XI

- At the end of the year, in order to be declared passed and promoted to the next higher class, a student must secure at **least 33% in each subject separately in Theory and Practical Exam.**
- A student who **fails in the theory in the Annual Examination** will be placed in the Compartment Exam.
- A student is eligible to appear in **only ONE Compartment Exam.**
- In order to be declared “passed” in the Compartment Exam a student must secure **at least 33% marks in the subject in which she has taken the Compartment Exam.**
- A student **who does not pass the Compartment Exam** shall be detained in the same class during the next session.
