

# Republic Day Celebration and Investiture Ceremony

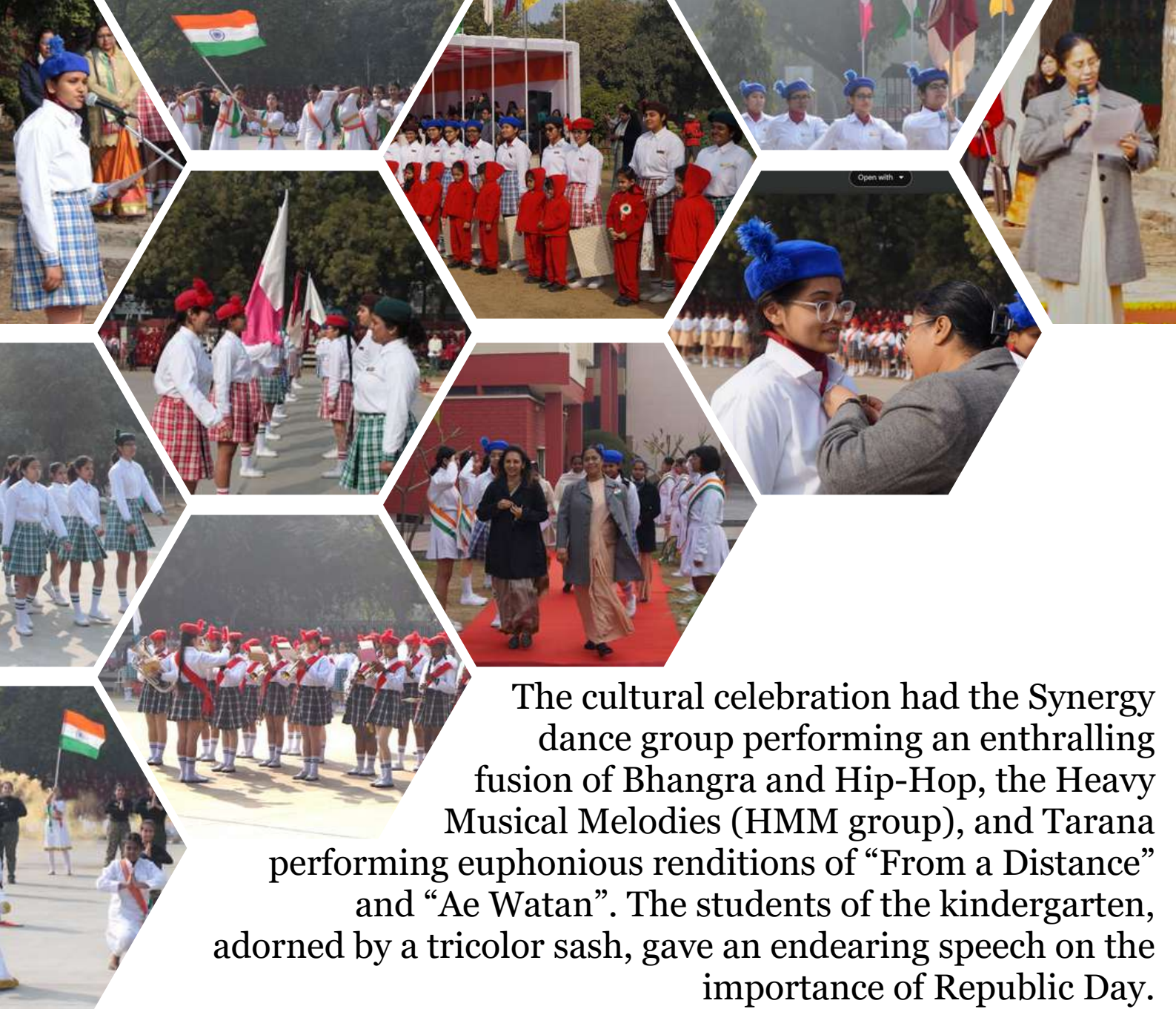
