

German Language Diplomas awarded to the German learning students of Carmel Convent School

German Language Diplomas were awarded to the students of the Carmel Convent School, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi on 23th August 2022. Mr. Johannes Höber, counsellor and Head of Cultural Department, Embassy of Federal Republic of Germany, New Delhi was Chief Guest for the ceremony, to do the honours of handing over the the DSDI and DSDII certificates to 34 students of the school. The German Diploma Level I (DSDI) was introduced in the school in 2015. Since then, approximately 20-30 students are writing the diploma successfully every year. In 2018 the school students received the permission to write the Diploma Level II Exam (DSD II). Each year students from Carmel are able to pursue their studies in Germany on receiving the scholarship.
